

MINUTES OF THE VILLAGE OF UNIONVILLE COUNCIL MEETING HELD
ON FEBRUARY 15, 2010

President Dean Hartman called the meeting to order at 7pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.
Present: Kathy Hare, Christina Matthews, Dale Hartman, Tom Young, Mike Gremel, Connie Sy and Deputy Clerk, Laura Leskowich.

Guest: Dan Bell representing Bell Equipment Company.

Motion by T. Young, second by C. Sy, to approve the minutes from the previous meeting as read. 7Yeas.
Motion carried.

Mr. Bell approached the council with a presentation on several used street sweepers. Since the village is in need of a street sweeper and funds are limited, council felt a used sweeper would probably be the best option and will consider this matter for the next fiscal year.

Two dog complaints were presented to the council. The council felt this was a matter for the police department and turned it over to the Village Police Chief.

The DPW Supervisor reported that it is necessary to replace village water meters in the very near future. Dave Yoder will seek quotes from several meter companies and Mike Gremel will research ways to finance this project.

Several items were presented for consideration when the 2010-2011 fiscal years' budget is prepared. With the poor economy in mind, the wage committee recommended a wage freeze for the coming year. Motion by M. Gremel, second by Connie Sy, to purchase 6 signs at \$18.00ea. to be installed in the park regarding the responsibilities of dog owners when walking their dogs in the park. 7Yeas. Motion carried. A local farmer requested permission to tie his farm drain into village storm sewers. After a brief discussion, the council concluded that this could cause some major problems in the future and therefore denied the request.

DPW Supervisor reported that the foam in the ridge cap on the tool shed needs to be replaced. This will be taken care of during the new fiscal year.

It was reported that MDOT has ordered a historical survey for the village downtown area and the Community Association will need three plans for street lighting, good, better and best and would require 20% of the financing.

Motion by T. Young, second by M. Gremel, to pay the bills for February. 7Yeas. Motion carried.
