

MINUTES OF THE VILLAGE OF UNIONVILLE COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON  
NOVEMBER 16, 2009

President Dean Hartman called the meeting to order at 7pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Kathy Hare, Nick Sakon, Dale Hartman, President Pro-tem, Mike Gremel, Connie Sy and Deputy Clerk, Laura Leskovich. The Village Police Chief and the DPW Superintendent were also in attendance.

Absent: Tom Young

Motion by Mike Gremel, seconded by Nick Sakon, to accept the minutes from the previous meeting as read. 6Yeas. Motion carried.

Mr. Jim Reinhold of Neptune Water Meters was present to demonstrate Neptune's radio meters, with the prospect of the village upgrading their present meter system to a remote system.

The entire council felt that a project of this magnitude was not feasible at this time. However the village will look into a possible grant for the future

Discussion was held on the malicious destruction of the flower pots in the downtown area. The Village Police Chief will look into this matter and devise a possible solution.

Parents should be reminded that Section 14 Article 246 of the Village of Unionville code of ordinances states that parents or guardians of any child or minor person are responsible for their actions and they can and will be fined and or arrested should they be identified.

Due to several delinquent water bills the matter of shut-off notices was discussed at length.

Village Ordinance Section 28 Article 136 was reviewed. The ordinance clearly states that any account not paid within sixty (60) days after the date of the bill shall render the subject premises ineligible for continued service. The village will continue to enforce this ordinance.

The DPW Superintendent presented a report as follows:

1. A leaky shut-off valve in the Kemp Memorial Park has been repaired.
2. The Village of Akron has been contracted to sweep the streets until the village is able to purchase a used sweeper. The Equipment committee will look into the prospect of purchasing a used street sweeper.
3. Christmas decorations will be put up during the first week of December.
4. A part for the controls at the grinder station has been ordered. Until the new part arrives and is installed the pump is being turned on manually.

The matter of the obsolete furnace in the conference room was discussed. The Building and Maintenance committee will look into this matter and whether or not it is possible to run duct work from the village office to the conference room, thus utilizing the office furnace.

Motion by Kathy Hare, seconded by Mike Gremel, to pay the bills for November. 6Yeas. Motion carried.
