

APPROVED MINUTES OF THE VILLAGE OF UNIONVILLE COUNCIL MEETING HELD
ON AUGUST 17, 2009

President Dean Hartman called the meeting to order at 7pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Kathy Hare, Nick Sakon, Dale Hartman, Tom Young, Mike Gremel, Connie Sy, and Deputy Clerk Laura Leskovich.

Motion by Mike Gremel second by Kathy Hare, to approve the minutes from the previous meeting as read. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Deb Bitzer, representing St. Paul Lutheran Church and (Christ the King School) approached the council with a request to use the village park to hold a pee-wee walk-a-thon on September 27th with October 7th as a contingency date in case of rain. Permission was granted to proceed with their plans and the council wished them luck.

Air Advantage President Scott Zimmer, appeared before the council to negotiate the tower rent contract.

Motion by Connie Sy second by Nick Sakon, to approve the present contract with the stipulation that the contract be renegotiated on a yearly basis. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Joseph Kenny spoke to the council on the matter of placing a Desert Storm monument in the Kemp Memorial Park in honor of our American Troops. The Community Association would enter an essay writing contest with the hope of winning the statue for the park. The council was in favor of the plan and assured them that the village would also help to achieve this goal.

The Unionville Fire Dept. requested permission to build a large pavilion in the park at their expense. A decision will be made after the council has studied their plans.

Motion by Tom Young second by Kathy Hare, to place the village clerk, Carole Gangler on the village checking account as an additional signer. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the matter of the necessity of raising water rates. Brian Minor from Rural Water will be contacted to help the village determine the stages of the increases.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Nick Sakon, to replace the steel door on the tool shed with the cost not to exceed \$300 for parts and labor. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Nick Sakon, to pay the bills for August.
