

**APPROVED MINUTES OF THE UNIONVILLE VILLAGE COUNCIL MEETING
HELD ON MARCH 16, 2009**

President Pro-Tem Dean Hartman called the meeting to order at 7pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Kathy Hare, Nick Sakon, Tom Young, Earl Bailey and Deputy Clerk Laura Leskowich.

Absent: David Duke and Mike Gremel

Motion by T. Young, second by N. Sakon, to approve the minutes from the previous meeting as read. 5Yeas. Motion carried.

A letter of resignation from President David Duke was presented to the council. The letter stated he has other commitments at this time and these commitments would interfere with his work at the village.

Motion by E. Bailey, second by N. Sakon, to accept President Duke's resignation. 5yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by T. Young, second by E. Bailey, to appoint Dean Hartman Village President. Roll Call Vote: Kathy Hare: Yea, Nick Sakon: Yea, Tom Young: Yea, Earl Bailey: Yea. Motion carried.

Three residents addressed the council with storm sewer problems. The DPW will inspect these problems this week. The council assured the residents that storm sewers are scheduled for inspection and cleaning this spring and hopefully the problems will be resolved at that time.

The DPW supervisor reported that they have discovered three manholes below ground. The DPW was unaware of their existence and therefore have been neglected. Due to the fact that they are below ground they will need manhole risers and cleaning.

Motion by E. Bailey, second by N. Sakon, to order three manhole risers. 5yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by T. Young, second by N. Sakon, to adopt the Tuscola County Hazard Mitigation Plan. 5Yeas. Motion carried.

This resolution will be kept on file as permanent record.

DPW Supervisor reported that the dikes at the lagoons are in need of repair and the DEQ will be here this week to inspect the rip-rap. The DEQ will then advise the village in regard to the necessary procedure for repair.

Motion by N. Sakon, second by K. Hare, to allow the Knights of Columbus the use of village streets for their Tootsie Roll drive on April 3rd and 4th. 5Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by T. Young, second by N. Sakon, to pay the bills for March.
