Motion by Tom Young, second by Dale Hartman, to approve the minutes from the previous regular meeting as read. 5Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Mike Gremel, second by Tom Young, to approve the minutes from the Year-End and Budget hearing as read. 5Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Mike Gremel, to appoint Clerk: Carole Gangler to another two-year term, Treasurer: Leila Rish to another two-year term and Deputy Clerk: Laura Leskowich to another two-year term. 5Yeas. Motion carried.

Sealed bids for the 2010 street repairs were opened and reviewed.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Mike Gremel, to accept the lowest bid of \$33,351.60 by Saginaw Asphalt for street repair on Phelps St. from Brown St. west to Railroad St. and Marvin St. from M-25 north to Church St. 5Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Mike Gremel, second by Connie Sy, to place delinquent utility accounts #116, #036, #037, #111, and #131 on the 2010 tax roll. 5Yeas. Motion carried.

The matter of monies received from a law suit with Cove Sanitation was tabled for future discussion.

A short discussion was held on the matter of the rising cost of employee health insurance. The insurance committee will research cost saving options and report their findings at the next council meeting.
