

**MINUTES OF THE VILLAGE OF UNIONVILLE COUNCIL MEETING  
HELD ON JULY 19, 2010**

President Dean Hartman called the meeting to order at 7pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Kathy Hare, Christina Matthews, Dale Hartman, Tom Young, Connie Sy and Deputy Laura Leskowich. Also present DPW Supervisor Dave Yoder, Village Treasurer Leila Rish. Motion by T. Young, second by Connie Sy to accept minutes from the previous meeting as read 6 yeas motion carried.

Auditor Joann Lakke from Nietzke Faupel, reported on the ACW Unionville Fire Dept. audit for the previous fiscal year.

Motion by Kathy Hare, second by Tom Young, to hire Nathan Izydorek to search for grants for the new water meters being considered for purchase by the Village. 6 yeas motion carried  
Bids for water meters submitted by Municipal Supply (Badger meters) and RIO Supply (Neptune meters) were opened and read. The bids will be analyzed and awarded at the August 16, 2010 council meeting.

Sidewalk repair bids for the summer 2010 were opened and reviewed.

Motion by Connie Sy, second by Kathy Hare, to accept Faber Masonry's bid for the 2010 sidewalk repairs. 6 yeas motion carried.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Kathy Hare, to remove Mike Gremel from the village bank accounts due to his resignation from the council. 6 yeas motion carried

Motion by Tom Young, second by Christina Matthews, to appoint Dale Herman trustee to complete the remaining 2 yr. term vacated by Mike Gremel. 6 yeas motion carried.

Christina Matthews made a motion second by Connie Sy to have a Village Clean Up Day for Saturday, August 21, 2010 between 9am and 5pm. 6 yeas motion carried.

Judy Remar, Leon Stecker and Sherry Libracki from the Community Association addressed the council requesting action on the problem of blight in the village and the need for additional police protection in the evening.

Motion by Kathy Hare, second by Tom Young, to close Church and Marvin St. for the Summer Festival, to be held on, Saturday August 7, 2010. 6 yeas motion carried.

Motion by Christina Matthews second by Connie Sy to allow a petting zoo on village property during the Summer Festival. 6 yeas motion carried.

Old business :

- Employee manuals were discussed at length, many changes were recommended and council will act on this matter in the near future.
- East village boundary has been defined and a village limit sign will be placed.
- Need for insulation in board room will be handled by the DPW
- Carpet samples for the board room will be selected before the next meeting.

Motion by Dale Hartman, second by Tom Young, to pay the bills 6 yeas motion carried.
