President Dean Hartman called the meeting to order at 7pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Kathy Hare, Christina Matthews, Dale Hartman, Tom Young, Mike Gremel, Connie Sy, and Deputy Clerk Laura Leskovich.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Mike Gremel, to approve the minutes from the previous meeting as read. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Mike Gremel, second by Dale Hartman to reduce the sewer bill by \$105.16 on account #249 due to extenuating circumstances. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Christina Matthews, to transfer \$24,000 from Street & Sidewalk fund to General Fund. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Connie Sy, to purchase a GP Series 8000 generator from Generac Power Systems at a cost of \$1625. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Mike Gremel, to allow the Knights of Columbus the use of village streets for their annual Tootsie Roll drive on March 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Mike Gremel, second by Kathy Hare, to allow the American Legion the use of village streets to conduct their annual poppy sales drive on May 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Connie Sy, second by Christina Matthews to allow the Unionville Community Association the use of the main park to hold an Easter egg hunt on April 3<sup>rd</sup> at 10am. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Connie Sy, second by Tom Young, granting the Unionville Community Association permission to place cement flower pots in the downtown area. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Mike Gremel, to hire American Fence Company to replace a backstop in the park at a cost of \$3,250. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Mike Gremel, second by Dale Hartman, to accept a proposal of \$1,395 from Dyer Plumbing to install duct work in the village board room. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Kathy Hare, to purchase six new picnic tables from Great Lakes Lift & Dock at \$390 each. 6Yeas, 1Nay. Motion carried.

Motion by Mike Gremel, second by Tom Young, to allow the Lions Club the use of village streets for their annual white cane drive during the last weekend in April. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Several blight problems within the village were addressed. The matter was turned over to the village police chief, along with a complaint on dogs.

The Village Treasurer reported that \$52,276.16 from the CDARS account should be reinvested.

Motion by Christina Matthews, second by Mike Gremel, to invest monies with Team One in a 12 Month CD at 1.2%. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

It was reported that the summer 10-hour work day for the DPW will begin on April 1, 2010.

Motion by Mike Gremel, second by Kathy Hare to send Brent to a class in Coldwater in preparation for his water certification test. 7Yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Tom Young, second by Mike Gremel, to pay the bills for March. 7Yeas. Motion carried.
